

PUBLIC OFFER

STRONG SPIRITS GAMES 2026

Official event dates: 24-27 September 2026 | Competition days: 25-26 September 2026 | Semmering, Austria

This public offer (hereinafter, the "Offer") is an official proposal of the Public Organization "Strongman Federation of Ukraine" (hereinafter, the "Organizer") to enter into an agreement for participation in the international sporting event Strong Spirits Games 2026 (hereinafter, the "Event") on the terms set out below.

Acceptance of this Offer is effected by the Participant performing one or a combination of the following actions: registration on the official Event website, confirmation of participation, payment of the registration fee, receipt of registration confirmation, or actual participation in the Event. From the moment of acceptance, this Offer constitutes an agreement between the Organizer and the Participant in accordance with the law applicable to such legal relations.

The terms of this Offer apply together with the official Competition Regulations, the rules of the relevant discipline, the Cancellation and Refund Policy, the Privacy Policy, and other documents published by the Organizer on the official website.

1. TERMS AND DEFINITIONS

- 1.1. Organizer - the Public Organization "Strongman Federation of Ukraine" (identification code 37935889), which organizes and conducts the Event, accepts registration fees, and interacts with Participants in accordance with this Offer.
- 1.2. Event - the international sporting event "Strong Spirits Games 2026", organized by the Organizer in Semmering, Austria, on the dates published on the official website.
- 1.3. Participant - an individual who has registered to participate in Strong Spirits Games 2026 competitions and has accepted the terms of this Offer.
- 1.4. Registration - submission by the Participant of the registration form through the official website, including the required personal, sporting, and contact information.
- 1.5. Registration Fee - the fee for participation in the Event, the amount of which depends on the selected division and category and is published on the official website.
- 1.6. Division / Category - the sporting group in which the Participant registers according to sex, weight, status, level of preparation, classification, or other criteria established by the Competition Regulations.
- 1.7. Regulations - a separate document or set of official documents of the Organizer defining eligibility conditions, the program, events, judging rules, weigh-in procedures, classification, and other sporting matters.

- 1.9. Organizing Committee - persons authorized by the Organizer to carry out the administrative, sporting, technical, and operational management of the Event.
- 1.10. Event Partner - a legal entity or individual participating in the support, financing, provision, or media coverage of the Event on the basis of separate arrangements with the Organizer.

2. PURPOSES AND OBJECTIVES OF THE EVENT

- 2.1. The Organizer of Strong Spirits Games 2026 is the Public Organization "Strongman Federation of Ukraine".
- 2.2. The Event is held to develop and promote strength and adaptive sports, create an international environment for sporting competition and exchange of experience, and enable athletes to represent their countries.
- 2.3. The main objectives of the Event are: to engage athletes of different levels of preparation; improve sporting performance; develop international cooperation; promote fair competition, mutual respect, strength, and resilience; and create equal and safe conditions for participation in accordance with the Regulations.
- 2.4. Individual sporting divisions, categories, and participation formats are determined by the Organizer and published on the official website.

3. DATE AND VENUE

- 3.1. Official dates of Strong Spirits Games 2026: 24-27 September 2026. Main competition days: 25-26 September 2026.

3.2. Venue: Semmering, Austria. The exact venue address, accreditation times, weigh-in times, briefings, and start times are published separately by the Organizer.

3.3. The Organizer may make reasonable changes to the schedule, start times, order of disciplines, event zones, or technical program, provided that Participants are informed through the official website and/or the contact details supplied during registration.

3.4. In the event of a material change to the date or venue, Section 18 of this Offer and the Cancellation and Refund Policy shall apply.

4. ORGANIZATION AND MANAGEMENT OF THE EVENT

4.1. Overall management of the Event is carried out by the Organizer through the Organizing Committee.

4.2. For the purpose of conducting the Event, the Organizer may engage judges, technical personnel, medical personnel, volunteers, security services, contractors, local partners, and other persons.

4.3. The organization of the Event in Austria is carried out with due regard to the mandatory requirements of Austrian law, venue rules, and other applicable rules relating to safety, public events, medical support, personal data protection, and consumer rights.

4.4. Sporting matters not regulated by this Offer are governed by the Regulations and decisions of the chief judging panel within its competence.

5. PARTICIPANT REGISTRATION AND PAYMENT

5.1. Registration is completed through the official website <https://strongspiritsgames.com/>.

5.2. To register, the Participant completes the form, selects a division and category, uploads the required materials, and confirms the accuracy of the information provided.

5.3. The current registration deadline is 15 September 2026. The Organizer may close registration earlier if the maximum number of Participants is reached or for other reasonable organizational reasons.

5.4. The amount of the Registration Fee is determined according to the selected division and category and is published on the official website before payment is made.

5.5. Payment of the Registration Fee is made through PayPal in accordance with the Organizer's official payment instructions or by another method expressly published by the Organizer.

5.6. After payment, the Participant must send a screenshot or receipt confirming the payment to WhatsApp +380 63 935 12 88 or to strongspiritsgames@gmail.com, stating the Participant's full name, country, division, and weight category.

5.7. Submission of the registration form alone does not guarantee a place in the competition. Registration is considered confirmed after payment has been received and verified, the submitted information has been checked, and the Participant has received official confirmation by email or WhatsApp.

5.8. Where necessary, after registration has been confirmed, the Organizer may provide the Participant with an official invitation for visa or travel purposes. Such invitation does not guarantee the issuance of a visa, permission to enter a country, or permission to cross a border.

5.9. Payment of the Registration Fee does not transfer to the Participant any intellectual property rights in the Strong Spirits Games name, logo, symbols, photographs, videos, or other Event materials.

6. CANCELLATION, REFUNDS, AND TRANSFER OF REGISTRATION

6.1. The Participant may cancel their registration by sending a written request to strongspiritsgames@gmail.com. The cancellation date is the date on which the Organizer receives the request.

6.2. If the cancellation request is received on or before 15 August 2026, the Participant will receive a refund of 80% of the Registration Fee paid.

6.3. If the request is received from 16 August through 31 August 2026, the Participant will receive a refund of 50% of the Registration Fee paid.

6.4. If the request is received on or after 1 September 2026, the Registration Fee is non-refundable, except in cases expressly provided for by this Offer, the separate Cancellation and Refund Policy, or mandatory provisions of applicable law.

6.5. In the event of a documented serious injury or health condition that makes participation impossible, the Organizer may apply special refund or fee-transfer conditions in accordance with the published Cancellation and Refund Policy.

6.6. In the event of a visa refusal, special refund conditions may apply only if documents were submitted in a timely manner and an official decision of the competent authority is provided in accordance with the Cancellation and Refund Policy.

6.7. Until 10 September 2026, the Participant may request that the registration be transferred to another athlete. Such transfer is permitted only with the Organizer's written approval, verification that the replacement athlete meets the applicable requirements, availability in the category, and completion by the replacement athlete of all registration requirements.

6.8. Procedures, deadlines, administrative deductions, and refunds in the event of postponement or cancellation of the Event are also governed by the separate Cancellation and Refund Policy published on the official website. In the event of a conflict, the provision that does not restrict the Participant's mandatory rights under applicable law shall apply.

6.9. Since participation in the Event is a service connected with a sporting/leisure event held during a specifically defined period, any right to withdraw from a distance contract applies only to the extent provided by mandatory legal provisions applicable to the particular Participant.

7. ELIGIBILITY, DOCUMENTS, AND ACCREDITATION

7.1. Persons are eligible to participate if they meet the requirements of the relevant division and category, complete registration, pay the Registration Fee, and provide the required documents.

7.2. The Participant must have a passport or other valid identity document, registration confirmation, proof of payment, and any other documents expressly required by the Regulations.

7.3. For Military Strongman or any other category in which participation depends on military, veteran, or other special status, the Organizer may require documentary evidence of such status.

7.4. If supporting documents are required for adaptive or medical classification, the Participant must provide them within the time limits and in the form established by the Organizer.

7.5. The Organizer may require medical clearance or other health-related documents where provided for by the Regulations, venue requirements, insurance conditions, or applicable law.

7.6. The Participant is solely responsible for obtaining a passport, visa, entry permits, travel and medical insurance, travel documents, and any other documents required to travel to Austria.

7.7. Failure to provide mandatory documents may result in refusal of entry to the competition without refund of the Registration Fee, unless otherwise required by mandatory provisions of applicable law.

8. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

8.1. Participants must comply with this Offer, the Regulations, judges' decisions, venue rules, safety rules, and lawful instructions of persons authorized by the Organizer.

8.2. Participants must respect other athletes, judges, volunteers, partners, staff, spectators, and security personnel and must not engage in insults, threats, violence, discrimination, or behavior that creates a danger.

8.3. A competition Participant must appear on time for accreditation, weigh-in, briefings, the start, ceremonies, and other mandatory activities included in the official program.

8.4. Before performing an event, the Participant must ensure that the equipment is correctly adjusted and immediately report any malfunction or hazard to a judge or technical staff member.

8.5. The Participant has the right to receive up-to-date information about the schedule, rules, category, results, and organizational changes through the Organizer's official channels.

8.6. The Participant may submit protests or appeals regarding judging only in the manner and within the time limits established by the Regulations.

9. PROHIBITED ACTIONS AND ITEMS

9.1. Actions that violate public order, safety, the rights of others, venue rules, or applicable law are prohibited within the Event area.

9.2. It is prohibited to be present in the competition area while under the influence of alcohol or drugs; to use prohibited narcotic or psychotropic substances; to make threats; to engage in violence or intentional damage to property; or to make racist, xenophobic, discriminatory, or degrading statements.

9.3. Access to technical, judging, medical, anti-doping, staff, or other restricted areas without specific authorization is prohibited.

9.4. It is prohibited to bring weapons, explosives, pyrotechnics, flammable, toxic, or radioactive substances, as well as any other items prohibited by Austrian law or the rules of the specific venue.

9.5. Professional photography, video recording, broadcasting, or commercial media activity may require prior accreditation or the Organizer's written approval.

9.6. The Organizer and venue security may deny access to a person carrying prohibited items or whose behavior poses a reasonably justified safety threat, within the limits of applicable law.

10. SAFETY, EMERGENCIES, AND EVACUATION

10.1. In the event of fire, a security threat, extreme weather, a technical incident, evacuation, or another emergency, Participants must immediately follow the instructions of the Organizer, venue security, police, fire service, medical service, or rescue service.

10.2. Participants must remain calm, must not obstruct evacuation or block passageways, and must give priority to persons requiring assistance.

10.3. The Organizer may temporarily suspend, postpone, or modify the competition program if necessary to protect human life and health.

10.4. The Organizer will inform Participants of designated evacuation routes and safety rules to the extent necessary for the specific venue.

11. MEDICAL SUPPORT AND HEALTH

11.1. Participation in strength sports competitions involves increased physical exertion. By registering, the Participant confirms that they assess their own health and physical readiness for the chosen type of physical load.

11.2. The Organizer recommends that Participants undergo a medical examination before travel and refrain from participation if a health condition may create a danger to the Participant or to other persons.

11.3. Where medically justified, an authorized medical professional may recommend or require that a Participant not be admitted to, or discontinue participation in, a specific event or competition, within the limits of applicable law and Event rules.

11.4. The Participant must inform the Organizer or medical personnel of any known circumstances that may directly affect the safety of participation if disclosure of such information is required by the Regulations or medical procedures.

11.5. Medical support for the Event is organized within the requirements of applicable law, venue rules, and the approved safety plan.

12. ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISKS AND LIABILITY

12.1. The Participant understands that strongman and other strength disciplines are forms of physical activity involving an increased risk of injury, including risks arising from falls, overexertion, contact with equipment, weather conditions, the Participant's own mistakes, or unforeseen sporting situations.

12.2. The Participant assumes the ordinary and obvious sporting risks inherently associated with voluntary participation in the relevant disciplines, provided that the Organizer properly performs the duties imposed on it by applicable law.

12.3. The Organizer is not liable for loss, theft, or damage to the Participant's personal property unless such liability arises from the Organizer's intent, gross negligence, or in other cases where liability cannot lawfully be excluded or limited.

12.4. Nothing in this Offer excludes or limits the Organizer's liability where such exclusion or limitation is prohibited by mandatory provisions of applicable law, including in relation to intent, gross negligence, or the protection of life and health.

12.5. The Participant is solely responsible for expenses related to travel, accommodation, meals, visas, insurance, personal equipment, and other costs unless the Organizer expressly states otherwise.

13. LIABILITY FOR VIOLATION OF THE RULES

13.1. For violations of the Regulations, safety requirements, rules of conduct, or lawful instructions of authorized persons, the Participant may be subject to a warning, cancellation of an event result, penalty points, disqualification, termination of accreditation, or removal from the Event area.

13.2. Decisions on sporting disqualification are made in accordance with the Regulations and within the competence of the judging panel.

13.3. In the event of a serious violation that may constitute an offense, the Organizer may contact the competent Austrian authorities or provide them with necessary information within the limits of the law.

13.4. Disqualification caused by the Participant's violation of the rules does not automatically create a right to a refund of the Registration Fee.

14. PERSONAL DATA AND PRIVACY

14.1. During registration and the conduct of the Event, the Organizer processes Participants' personal data required for registration, communication, preparation of start lists, accreditation, classification, results, safety, visa support, and other organizational purposes.

14.2. Personal data is processed in accordance with the Law of Ukraine "On Personal Data Protection" and, where applicable, the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and other mandatory rules.

14.3. The Organizer shall provide Participants with information about the controller, purposes, legal bases, categories of data, retention periods, recipients, international transfers, and data subject rights in the Privacy Policy or a separate data processing notice.

14.4. The Participant has rights regarding their personal data within the limits of applicable law, including the rights of access, rectification, erasure, restriction, objection, data portability, and withdrawal of consent where processing is based on consent.

14.5. Where the law requires separate consent for a particular type of processing, including marketing use of personal data, such consent must be obtained separately from acceptance of this Offer.

15. PHOTO, VIDEO, AUDIO MATERIALS, AND USE OF IMAGE

15.1. Official photography, video recording, and audio recording may take place during the Event for the purposes of documentation, broadcasting, media coverage, publication of sporting results, archiving, and promotion of Strong Spirits Games.

15.2. The Participant understands that, as a participant in a public sporting event, they may appear in general, group, reportage, or broadcast footage.

15.3. Use of materials containing the Participant's image is carried out on an appropriate legal basis and with due regard to applicable laws on personal data protection, image rights, and copyright.

15.4. If the law requires consent for a particular advertising, personalized, or commercial use of an image, the Organizer shall obtain such consent separately, in a clear and unambiguous form.

15.5. The Participant does not acquire ownership rights in official photo, video, or audio materials created by the Organizer or its authorized partners unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing.

16. ANTI-DOPING REQUIREMENTS

16.1. The Organizer supports the principles of fair sport and the prohibition of prohibited substances and methods where the relevant anti-doping rules apply to a particular division or competition.

16.2. If anti-doping control is provided for by the Regulations, Participants must comply with the requirements of the competent anti-doping organization, report for testing following proper notification, and follow the established procedure.

16.3. Where applicable, anti-doping procedures are conducted in accordance with the current World Anti-Doping Code and WADA International Standards or the rules of another competent anti-doping organization.

16.4. Refusal to undergo mandatory anti-doping control or another violation of applicable anti-doping rules may result in disqualification and annulment of results.

17. RIGHTS OF THE ORGANIZER

17.1. The Organizer may determine and, within reasonable necessity, amend the program, start order, technical procedures, format of individual events, and organizational rules, provided that this does not conflict with mandatory law or the Regulations.

17.2. The Organizer may verify registration information, documents, category compliance, status, and other eligibility criteria.

17.3. The Organizer may refuse to confirm a registration if the Participant has not fulfilled mandatory conditions, has provided false information, has not paid the Registration Fee, does not meet category criteria, or where other reasonable grounds provided by the Regulations exist.

17.4. The Organizer may engage partners, contractors, and service providers necessary for conducting the Event.

17.5. The Organizer may decide organizational matters not regulated by this Offer, subject to compliance with the Regulations and mandatory provisions of law.

18. POSTPONEMENT, CANCELLATION, AND FORCE MAJEURE

18.1. Force majeure or other extraordinary circumstances may include dangerous weather conditions, natural disasters, fires, hostilities or terrorist threats, government restrictions, border closures, epidemics, strikes affecting critical services, closure of the venue, major transport or infrastructure disruptions, and other circumstances beyond the Organizer's reasonable control.

18.2. If such circumstances arise, the Organizer may modify the program, postpone the Event, change the venue, or cancel the Event if objectively necessary for safety or to make the Event possible.

18.3. If the Event is completely cancelled at the Organizer's initiative and no new date is offered, Participants will receive a refund of the Registration Fee in accordance with the Cancellation and Refund Policy and mandatory applicable law.

18.4. If the Event is postponed, registration remains valid for the new date, and the Participant has the alternatives provided by the Cancellation and Refund Policy and mandatory provisions of law.

18.5. The Organizer does not reimburse expenses paid by the Participant to third parties, including airfare, ground transportation, accommodation, visa services, insurance, meals, or personal equipment, except where such liability is expressly imposed by mandatory law.

18.6. The Organizer will notify Participants of material changes through the official website and using the contact details provided by the Participant during registration.

19. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

19.1. The Strong Spirits Games name, logos, graphic materials, design, texts, photographs, videos, broadcasts, results databases, and other materials may be protected by intellectual property rights belonging to the Organizer or the relevant rights holders.

19.2. Without prior written approval, it is prohibited to use the Event's official symbols in a manner that creates the impression of an official partnership, sponsorship, endorsement, or commercial relationship with the Organizer.

19.3. Participants may share their own Event materials for personal, non-commercial purposes, subject to the rights of other persons, venue rules, media accreditation requirements, and applicable law.

20. AMENDMENTS TO THE OFFER AND OFFICIAL DOCUMENTS

20.1. The Organizer may amend this Offer, the Regulations, and other official documents to clarify procedures, ensure safety, comply with legal requirements, or ensure proper organization of the Event.

20.2. The updated version is published on the official website with the date of the update.

20.3. Amendments must not retrospectively deprive the Participant of a mandatory right already acquired, unless otherwise expressly required by law or agreed with the Participant.

20.4. In the event of material changes, the Organizer will additionally inform registered Participants by email, WhatsApp, or another contact channel provided during registration.

21. APPLICABLE LAW AND DISPUTE RESOLUTION

21.1. This Offer is made by the Organizer, a legal entity registered in Ukraine. Ukrainian law applies to the contractual relationship to the extent that such a choice is permitted by the rules of private international law.

21.2. This choice of law does not deprive the Participant of the protection afforded by mandatory provisions of the law of the country of their habitual residence or by other mandatory provisions of European Union or Austrian law where such provisions apply to the particular legal relationship.

21.3. Matters of safety, public order, venue operation, and other matters directly related to conducting the Event in Austria are also governed by mandatory provisions of Austrian law.

21.4. The Parties shall seek to resolve disputes through negotiation and a written request to the Organizer. If a dispute is not resolved, it shall be decided by a competent court or other authority in accordance with the jurisdiction rules that mandatorily apply to the particular dispute.

21.5. Nothing in this Section limits a consumer's right to apply to consumer protection authorities or mechanisms available under mandatory applicable law.

22. FINAL PROVISIONS

22.1. This Offer enters into force upon publication on the official website and remains in effect until completion of all obligations of the Parties arising in connection with Strong Spirits Games 2026.

22.2. All matters not regulated by this Offer are governed by the Regulations, other official Event policies, and applicable law.

22.3. If any provision is invalid or unenforceable, the remaining provisions of the Offer remain effective to the maximum extent permitted by law.

22.4. By accepting the Offer, the Participant confirms that they have read and understood its terms, have provided accurate registration information, and agree to comply with the rules of Strong Spirits Games 2026.

22.5. If the Offer is published in multiple languages, in the event of discrepancies between language versions, priority shall be determined by the Organizer in the relevant publication; however, this may not restrict the Participant's mandatory rights under applicable law.
